## Daily Expectations:

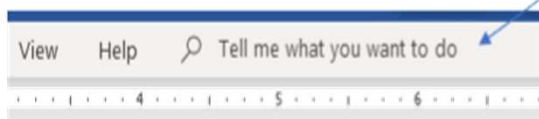
- ✓ Attendance IS REQUIRED and reported to the main office. This will count towards your final credit count.
- ✓ Students will sign in to Zoom (link in Remind App on the day before class) at the beginning of each scheduled class time and get the daily agenda.
